As an Assistant Manager, you will need two years of related experience within the food service industry or related industry. Excellent leadership skills and communication skills are a requirement when working with the Team Members and the Manager at your water park location.

Responsibilities include taking orders, operating a point-of-sale system (POS register), cash handling, fulfilling orders, food preparation, general cleaning, floor and equipment cleaning, restocking items and keeping inventory. To accommodate the many customers arriving every day from all over the Upstate, Rhino Concessions offers a variety of food and beverage options at four local water parks. From serving chicken tenders at the Caribbean Café at Discovery Island to providing fried Oreos at the Captain's Table at Shipwreck Cove; Rhino Managers oversee operations to make sure that no Customer walks away hungry!

Qualifications:

As the Manager at a water park location, you will need at least four years of related experience in the industry. Previous experience within a culinary education background and previous experience managing food service operation are not required but preferred. As the Manager, the ability to be personable, yet a respected leader will make you a successful Rhino Manager. The Manager is the final authority in the Concessions Area; leadership skills, communication skills, and professionalism are required for this position.

Responsibilities and Duties:

Your day will consist of coaching staff, monitoring operation functions, and building customer relationships. The work environment is fast paced and requires dedication to a variety of multiple tasks.

Managers will be managing two to six other members depending on the shift and day of the week. Managers will be exposed to heat, water, and hot cooking oil in a small working space. Cooking fryers, stove tops, pizza ovens, and other kitchen equipment will be used on a daily basis. Position requires long periods of standing, and may require some lifting (less than 50 pounds). This position also requires strong communication skills between the Assistant Manager and Team Members.

Managers will schedule Team Members and Associate Managers for their water park location, along with inputting daily settlement reports, and tracking and ordering inventory. Managers will promote the overall efficiency and productivity in the work place.

Dates and Hours:

Pre-season training will begin in late April/early May before the opening of the water parks in May. Operation hours will vary from 40 plus hours a week depending on the weather conditions.
